If only one heir survives and he/she merely wishes to confirm the title in himself/herself, this affidavit, with attachments, will be satisfactory. If one of the heirs is a surviving spouse and he/she wishes to transfer the vehicle to a new owner, the affidavit of heirship must be completed by him or her as well as all other heirs, but only the surviving spouse is required to execute a notarized bill of sale or act of donation. In case of transfer of a motor vehicle by any heir, when there is

no surviving spouse and the sale or donation is to a new owner, a proper bill of sale or act of donation must be executed by all heirs.

In each case the applicant must complete an application for title (DPSMV 1799) and surrender the previous title and the current registration certificate, if available. If that registration

certificate is not available, submit an additional fee of \$4.00 in order to prepare a duplicate.

Fees are \$18.50 for transfer of title, \$5.50 service handling fee, and license fees as applicable. If a lien is reflected on the application of the new owner, we will require a UCC1 Form or a certified copy of the mortgage with an additional fee of \$5.00. If a lien was reflected on the title of the decedent, we will require the paid note or an affidavit of satisfaction covering

the mortgage with an additional fee of \$5.00 for its cancellation. If a consideration is expressed in a bill of sale, the proper sales tax should also be computed and paid.
